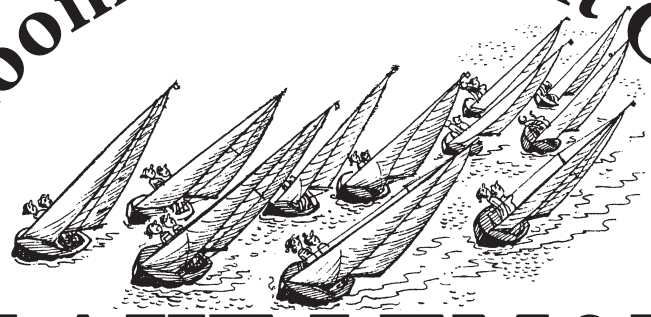

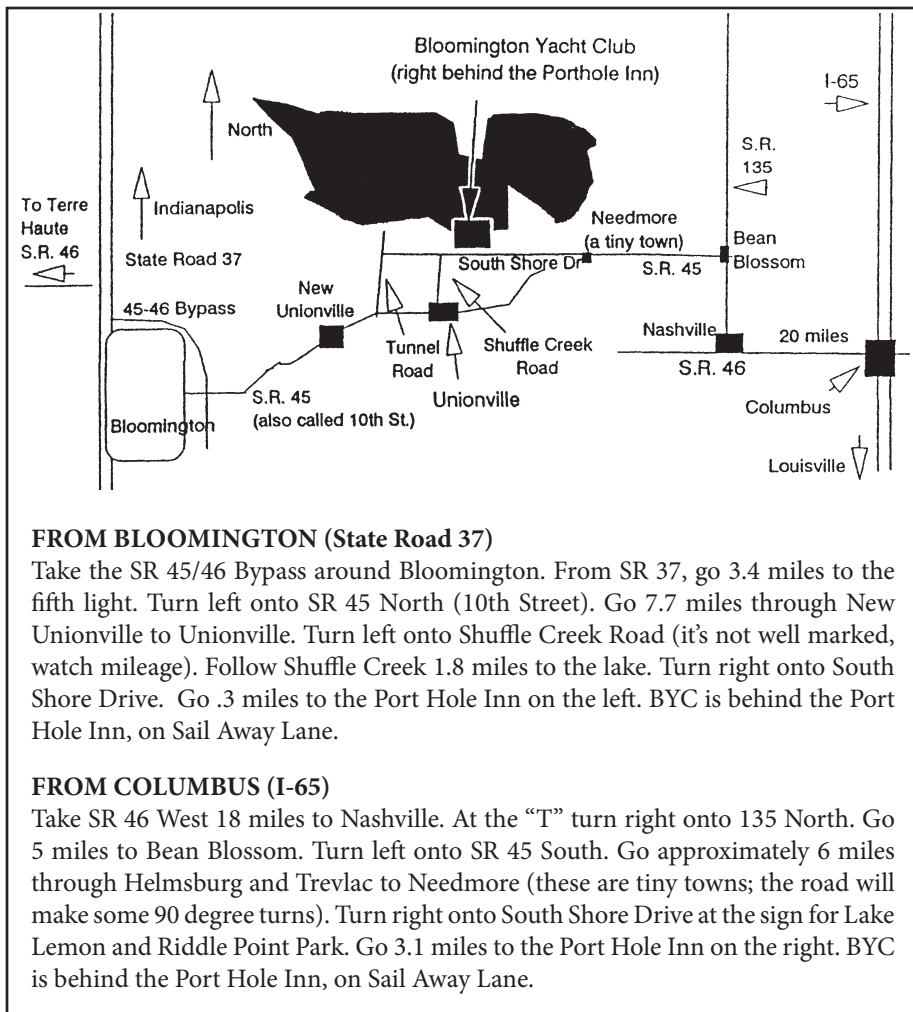

Bloomington, Indiana



FROM BLOOMINGTON (State Road 37)

Take the SR 45/46 Bypass around Bloomington. From SR 37, go 3.4 miles to the fifth light. Turn left onto SR 45 North (10th Street). Go 7.7 miles through New Unionville to Unionville. Turn left onto Shuffle Creek Road (it's not well marked, watch mileage). Follow Shuffle Creek 1.8 miles to the lake. Turn right onto South Shore Drive. Go .3 miles to the Port Hole Inn on the left. BYC is behind the Port Hole Inn, on Sail Away Lane.

FROM COLUMBUS (I-65)

Take SR 46 West 18 miles to Nashville. At the "T" turn right onto 135 North. Go 5 miles to Bean Blossom. Turn left onto SR 45 South. Go approximately 6 miles through Helmsburg and Trevlac to Needmore (these are tiny towns; the road will make some 90 degree turns). Turn right onto South Shore Drive at the sign for Lake Lemon and Riddle Point Park. Go 3.1 miles to the Port Hole Inn on the right. BYC is behind the Port Hole Inn, on Sail Away Lane.

FOOD

- All meals are included in the Regatta Fees for racers. Extra meals may be purchased for \$2 breakfast, \$2 lunch, \$8 dinner.
- Pancake breakfast on Sunday morning.
- A range and microwave are in the clubhouse. (Refrigerator reserved for food committee).

CLASSES

A Class Sloop-rigged boats 14½ feet long and over, Y-Flyer, Thistle, Flying Dutchman, Flying Scot, etc.

B Class All boats under 14½ feet overall, including Laser, Sunfish, Force 5, etc.

RULES & SCORING

USSAILING and Low Point Scoring System

RACES

A Class and B Class boats will have separate starts. More than 8 boats of any one-design class will have a separate start.

TROPHIES

There will be one trophy per four boats in a class.

FEES

Skipper..... \$45 (includes all meals)
 Crew Member..... \$10 (includes all meals)
 Youth Skipper(16 and Under).. \$20 (includes all meals)

Lake authorities have decreed that each yacht shall display a lake permit. Non-resident stickers will be available at registration (no extra charge).
